
Welcome Back & Happy New Year to all our Brindishe Families


We hope the new website contains all the information you need and prospective families will be interested in when choosing a school for their child. Any feedback and/or comments would be warmly received.

Brindishe Green is a 3 form entry Lewisham Local Authority Primary School providing an exciting education for children aged 3 -11 years, we are a few stops from Charing Cross, Waterloo, London Bridge mainline station or a short walk from Lee or Lewisham station. Brindishe Green is one of 3 schools in the Brindishe federation and works closely with Brindishe Manor and Brindishe Lee.

We are a very friendly team, working in a highly supportive environment where individual differences are welcome and teamwork is highly valued.

Our Federation of Brindishe schools respect and celebrate the rich, diverse community that surrounds us. We encourage individuality and ensure that children and staff are empowered to follow their own curiosity from whatever inspires them. We will discover how to become the best learners we can be, developing our knowledge, interests and needs through a diverse curriculum that allows us to follow our own learning journey.

The post involves:

As the role involves working with children, you will be required to undergo a full DBS check before being appointed to the post.
