What has been happening this week?

This week we have welcomed several visitors to school to share learning and messages with the children. Our visitors always speak so highly of the children and the level of engagement that they receive.

On Thursday we welcomed the London Fire Brigade to school, who worked with year 2 and year 5 pupils on fire safety. The children watched a presentation on how to keep themselves safe, how smoke alarms in your home can save lives and what to do if there is an emergency or fire. The children were also taught how to call 999. The fire brigade suggested that you may want to speak to your child/ren about how to exit your home in the event of a fire.

We welcomed Andrea Ellis (a former Brindishe Manor teacher) who is the development officer for girls and women's football at Bromley Football Club, to school this week.

She met with pupils from across the school to talk about women's football, how sport can support your mental health and wellbeing and how to get involved in football outside of school.

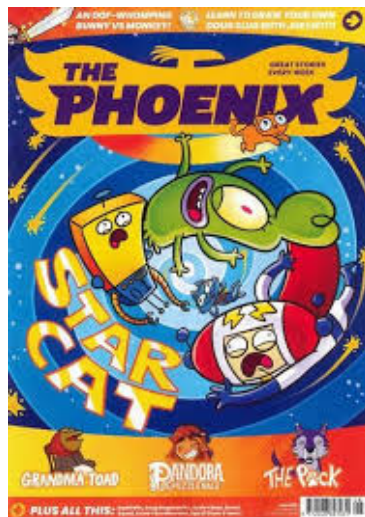
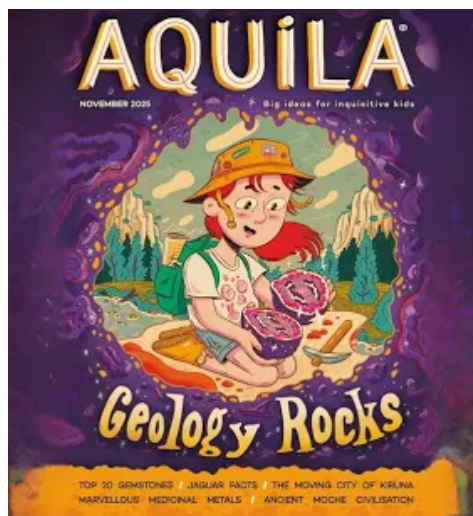
New PE and playground resources
