Please switch off your car engines

Thank you to our many parents and carers who park safely on or around our local streets – it is much appreciated.

Did you know that an idling engine can produce up to twice as many exhaust emissions as an engine in motion?

Exhaust emissions contain a range of air pollutants such as carbon monoxide, nitrogen dioxide, and particulate matter. These can affect the air quality of the surrounding environment and the air we breathe and are particularly bad for anyone with asthma, for young children, the elderly as well as you.

We ask everyone - please avoid sitting in your parked car outside school with the engine running. Remember to switch off as soon as your car is safely parked.

- turning off and restarting an engine causes less pollution than keeping the engine running.
- turning off your engine could help to reduce asthma, heart disease and lung cancer.
- idling wastes fuel and money and can increase wear and tear on your engine.
